There will also be an option to purchase onward travel discounts. The West Midlands Bus Scheme is funded by the Department for Transport and facilitated by Transport for West Midlands, aiming to promote a shift towards bus travel for those looking to change their travel habits. Applications will be accepted from October 17th, 2024, until October 31st, 2024, with processing beginning after the deadline
